Engage in safety committees or meetings and offer feedback and suggestions for improving safety practices.	Use of Safety Equipment Properly use and maintain safety equipment and PPE provided by Loram UK. This includes wearing appropriate clothing, helmets, gloves, safety glasses and other items as required.
		
Training and Awareness Attend and complete any required safety training programmes. Be aware of and understand the hazards associated with our job roles and the necessary safety precautions to take.	Emergency Response Loram employees will be familiar with emergency procedures, including evacuation routes and assembly points. In the event of an emergency they will follow established protocols and assist others as needed.	Compliance Loram employees will comply with all occupational health and safety policies, procedures, rules and regulations established by the organisation. This includes following safe work practices, using PPE when required and reporting any unsafe acts or conditions.
